

Reported Speech

Present Simple

John: - I **live** in London

→ **Past Simple**

→ John said (that) *he* **lived** in London

Present Continuous

Susan: - I **am writing** a letter

→ **Past Continuous**

→ Susan said (that) *she* **was writing** a letter

Present Perfect

Joe: - I **have written** a letter

→ **Past Perfect**

→ Joe said (that) *he* **had written** a letter

Past Simple

Joe: - I **wrote** a letter

→ **Past Perfect**

→ Joe said (that) *he* **had written** a letter

Past Perfect

Joe: - I **had written** a letter

→ **Past Perfect**

→ Joe said (that) *he* **had written** a letter

Future

Mary: - I **will write** a letter

→ **Conditional**

→ Mary said (that) *she* **would write** a letter

Imperative

Jim: - **Write** a letter

→ **To-infinitive**

→ Jim told me **to write** a letter
